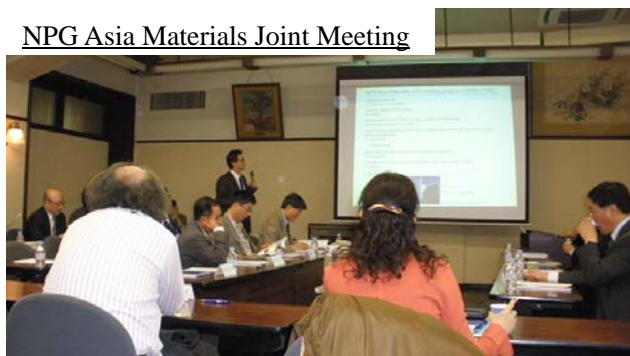
In the “NPG Asia Materials Joint Meeting”, committee members of the journal “NPG Asia Materials” from all over the Asian countries gathered at Tokyo Institute of Technology. The operation policy and future prospect of the journal were vigorously discussed in the meeting toward the next stage of the journal (Phase 3), which followed the Phase 1 (publishing the online journal, March 2008) and Phase 2 (publishing review articles, October 2009).

In the “Tokyo Tech – Tsinghua University Joint Symposium”, we held the joint symposium of the Material GCOE program (Department of Organic & Polymeric Materials, Department of Metallurgy & Ceramics Science, Department of Materials Science & Engineering, Department of Innovative & Engineered materials) and Tokyo Tech – Tsinghua University Joint Graduate Program. The committee members of the journal “NPG Asia Materials” as well as faculty members of Tsinghua University also joined the joint symposium. During the symposium, 13 faculty members gave lectures, and 26 Ph. D. students gave both oral and poster presentation in English. The Ph. D. students had great opportunities to discuss with world leading scientists during the symposium. It was also a good chance for the student for international exchange.
