

Activity Report: PM Course in 2007

1. Renewal of PM-course for G-COE program

Design of one of the G-COE education courses, Project Managing course (PM course), has been discussed and settled for the opening in 2008 spring semester. It is based on that has been operated in 21st Century COE for the past 4 years with 23 students having completed the course curriculum.

In the new G-COE, PM-course, "Business Communication Skills I and II" are renewed as "Global Communication Skills I and II" and they are compulsory subjects for not only PM course students but also for those of NI course. Then over 20 students are expected to enroll the subjects, therefore, in order to maintain the effective learning of communication skills, students will be grouped into two or more small size classes.

2. New Web-site for PM-course

One of the characteristics of the PM-course has been the inter-communication among students from four Departments related to materials science and teachers from business front through the web-site specially designed for the course. The site has been so well designed that there have always been active discussions among them who reside on different campuses and off-campus.
